The following crimes and incidents may be of interest to your local parish area. Written in order of receipt from 1st June – 30th June 2015

All rural areas

Throughout June police received reports regarding males attempting to sell various generators and other tools from the back of vehicles. A number of different vehicles are being used by the men. We urge that you do not buy anything from such callers to your address, no matter how good an offer it appears! Call Police at the time and if possible take vehicle details and descriptions.

Tarrington

1st June Theft of Sat-Nav from a Black Seat Altea overnight between 20:00 and 07:00hrs. Vehicle was parked in driveway of residential area, no damage to the vehicle.

Breinton

Theft of TWEMAN finishing Mower, large plant machinery used for collecting apples, which would have needed transport to move. Location was farmland open fields, happened sometime between 29th May - 1st June.

Sutton St Nicholas

Between 26th May and 3rd June whilst property unoccupied, persons unknown have stolen a large 6ft unique hand carved statue of 2 owls from front lawn. The statue could be seen from the roadway in the court yard area of only four houses.

Credenhill

5th June The rear window of a green Ford Mondeo smashed by means or persons unknown, no forced entry into vehicle, no CCTV in area.

Holmer

Cube mountain bike stolen from the communal area at the rear of Tremlett Ct, Red Norman rise, the Furlongs. Bike is black/White/Red in colour, last seen Friday/Saturday 7th June.

Credenhill

9th June – Suspicious incident where resident has discovered a chalk symbol of an arrow drawn on the front of their driveway by front door. Victim is concerned that the markings have been drawn by person(s) unknown in an attempt to identify the property for future crime offences. If you or anyone you know has found similar markings on or near property, do not attempt to remove before contacting police or photographing.

Dormington

A resident of The Maltings has informed SNT of the recent disappearance of two garden ornamental ducks. The ornament is of sentimental value and the owner requests that they are simply returned to the front garden they were taken from. Please contact SNT if any information regarding this.

Credenhill

Resident reported that her conservatory window has been shattered, between the hours of 1615-1730hrs on the 10th June, no witnesses, nothing seen or heard at the time.

Holmer

17th June – Theft of Pink Mongoose BMX bike from communal bike shed on The Furlongs. Despite the bike being locked, cutters were used.

Shelwick

19th June – At approx 22:00 an unknown male was seen stood inside a private garage. The male ran away from the area once he saw the residents of the property. Nothing damaged or stolen.

Stoke Edith

Between 22nd and 25th June offender(s) unknown have approached a large farm site. Damage has been caused to a security gate lock allowing entry into the compound. Once inside, they have proceeded to remove several drums containing high value cable. These have been stolen but some empty drums were found in the adjacent field.

Nupton

24th June. Report of suspicious vehicle vrm: NA62 NAJ Silver Nissan. No trace of this vehicle found on PNC. Driver of the vehicle were approached by a local resident who said they were looking for Brinsop. The resident made a similar report last month and felt it suspicious on both occasions.

Fownhope

28th June. Report of 3 males riding unauthorised motocross bikes around Fownhope to Brockhampton.
